SUBJECT: Commander's Policy on Urinalysis Program

1. The Army's war on drug abuse continues. USAREUR's aggressive urinalysis program has proven effective in reducing drug abuse. USAREUR has directed a 200 percent testing goal. Commanders may, at their discretion, exceed their 200 percent requirement up to 300 percent of unit strength using random selection methods. Commanders in the 80th Area Support Group will ensure:

a. All USAREUR soldiers undergo urinalysis at least twice each FY. Commanders will develop selection programs that meet the minimum of two tests per soldier per year. Frequent random testing of small sections is strongly recommended. Unpredictable testing is a powerful deterrent.

b. Soldiers enrolled in the Alcohol and Drug abuse Prevention and Control Program (ADAPCP) will comply with rehabilitation testing requirements established by their commander (AR 600-85).

2. Strong unit level command support enabled the 80th ASG to achieve the 200 percent testing goal in the past. On-going personal involvement and commitment by the chain of command is necessary to continue our success. I expect nothing less. The 80th ASG ADAPCP will assist commanders in monitoring progress and scheduling testing to reach the 200 percent goal.
